Four different vineyards make up this wine (from three soil types) that were picked between early Feb and early March, during a growing season that yielded a healthy crop (due to good winter rains) and cooler than average month of February.

Radley & Finch is a range of varietal wines made by Thinus Kruger and Pascal Schildt. Produced with a respect for place and a sense of purpose, these are wines for daily enjoyment. This range aims to reflect a light-hearted style of wine staying true to the most enjoyed grape varieties originating in South Africa. The motto: Optimism, beats the pants off pessimism. Whether it is poolside parties or beach bonfires, Radley & Finch is along for the ride. The grapes are meticulously sourced from sustainable farms near the Voor-Paardeberg Mountain (one hour north of Cape Town), with a smaller portion coming from Stellenbosch.

Tasting Notes

Due to varying picking dates, the wine has both spicier notes and blue characteristics (violets, blueberries etc) with a softer styled palate.
